Just as there are physical laws that govern the physical universe, so are there spiritual laws which govern your relationship with God.

God **LOVES** you and offers a wonderful **PLAN** for your life.

This is...

GOD'S LOVE

"God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16 NIV).

And...

GOD'S PLAN

[Christ speaking] "I came that they might have life, and might have it abundantly" (John 10:10) [that it might be full and meaningful].

Why is it that most people are not experiencing the abundant life?

Man is **SINFUL** and **SEPARATED** from God. Thus, he cannot know and experience God's love and plan for his life.

MAN IS SINFUL

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

Man was created to have fellowship with God; but, because of his stubborn self-will, he chose to go his own independent way, and fellowship with God was broken. This self-will, characterized by an attitude of active rebellion or passive indifference, is an evidence of what the Bible calls sin.

"We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way..." Isaiah 53:6

IFẸ ỌLỌRUN

"Nitori Ọlọrun fẹ araiye to bẹ gẹgẹ, ti o fi Ọmo bibi rẹ kanṣoṣo funni, ki ẹnikẹni ti o ba gbà a gbọ mà bà segbé, sugbọn ki o le ni iye ainipẹkun" (Johannu 3:16).

Ati...

ETO ỌLỌRUN

[Kristi wipe] "Emi wa ki nwọn le ni iye, ani ki nwọn le nii lọpọlọpọ" (Johannu 10:10). [Itumọ eyi ni: Igbesiaye kikun, ti o ni ìtélòrùn].

Ki iṣe gbogbo enia lo ngbe igbesiaye to kun to si ni ìtélòrùn nitoripe...

ENIA JẸ ẸLẸṢẸ

"Gbogbo enia li o sà ti sẹ, ti nwọn si kuna ogo Ọlọrun" (Romu 3:23).

Ọlọrun da enia ki a le ni irepọ t́mót́mó pẹlu Rẹ; sugbọn awa enia yàn lati bá Ona tiwa lọ, irepọ pẹlu Ọlọrun si ja. Títẹ si ọna ti ara wa ibase ninu ohun kekere tabi ohun nla jẹ eṣẹ. Ọrọ Ọlọrun lo sọ bẹẹ.

"Gbogbo wa ti sina káàkiri bi aguntan, olukuluku wa tẹle ọna ara rẹ..." (Isaiah 53:6)

MAN IS SEPARATED

“The wages of sin is death” [spiritual separation from God] (Romans 6:23).

This diagram illustrates that God is holy and man is sinful. A great gulf separates the two. The arrows illustrate that man is continually trying to reach God and the abundant life through his own efforts, such as a good life, philosophy, or religion – but he inevitably fails.



IYAPA WA L'ARIN ENIA ATI Q̄LQRUN

“Nitori iku li èrè èşş” [Itumọ eyi ni, iyapa ti ẹmi kuro lọdọ Q̄lqrun] (Romu 3:23)

Aworan yi fihan wipe, nitori Q̄lqrun jẹ mimọ enia jẹ ẹlẹş, iyapa nla wà láàrin awọn mejèèji. Aworan yi se apejuwe pe enia ngbiyanju lati de ọdọ Q̄lqrun. A lero pe bi a ba ş ẹsin dáadáa, tabi ki a jẹ enia rere, ki a máa gbadura, ki a máa lọ si ile Q̄lqrun (şọşi), bi a ko ba se ibi si ẹnikeji wa, ati bẹẹbẹẹ lọ, a o de ọdọ Q̄lqrun. Şugbọn asan ni gbogb iyanju yi.

HE DIED IN OUR PLACE

“God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us” (Romans 5:8).

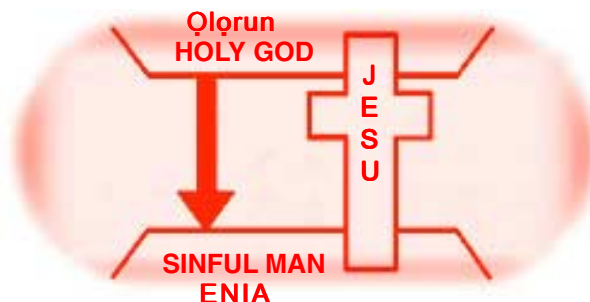
HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD

“Christ died for our sins...He was buried... He was raised on the third day, according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:3,4).

HE IS THE ONLY WAY TO GOD

“Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me’” (John 14:6).

This diagram illustrates that God has bridged the gulf which separates us from Him by sending His Son, Jesus Christ, to die on the cross in our place to pay the penalty for our sins.

It is not enough just to know these three laws...

We must individually **RECEIVE** Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord; then we can know and experience God's love and plan for our lives.

WE MUST RECEIVE CHRIST

“As many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name” (John 1:12)

“By grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast” (Ephesians 2:8,9).

WE RECEIVE CHRIST THROUGH PERSONAL INVITATION

[Christ speaking] *“Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any one hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him” (Revelation 3:20).*

Receiving Christ involves turning to God from self (repentance) and trusting Christ to come into our lives to forgive our sins and to make us what He wants us to be. Just to agree **intellectually** that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and that He died on the cross for our sins is not enough. Nor is it enough to have an **emotional** experience. We receive Jesus Christ by **faith**, as an act of the **will**.

These two circles represent two kinds of lives:

SELF-DIRECTED LIFE

Self is on the throne. Christ is outside the life. Interests are directed by self, often resulting in discord and frustration



CHRIST-DIRECTED LIFE

Christ is in the life and on the throne. Self is yielding to Christ. Interests are directed by Christ, resulting in harmony with God's plan.



ANI LATI GBA KRISTI NIPA IGBAGBỌ

“Sugbọn iye awon ti o gba a, awon li a fi agbara fun lati di omọ Ọlọrun, ani awon na ti o gbà orukọ rẹ gbọ.” (Johannu 1:12).

“Nitori ore-ọfẹ li a ti fi gba nyin là nipa igbagbọ... ki işe nipa işe ki ẹnikẹni mà ba şogo.” (Efesu 2:8,9).

ANI LATI GBA KRISTI NIPA PIPE E FUNARA WA

[Kristi wipe] *“Kiyesi i, mo duro li enu ilẹkun (ọkan rẹ), mo si nkànkun, bi ẹnikẹni ba gbọ Ohun mi, ti o si si Ilẹkun, emi o si wọle tọ ọ wa” (Ifihan 3:20).*

Itumọ gbigba Kristi ni wipe, ki a ni igbékèlé ninu Ọlọrun lati wa si inu igbesiaiye wa, ki O si dari ẹşẹ wa jì wa; ki a yipada kuro ninu ẹşẹ wa, ki a si jẹ ki Kristi wa gbe igbesiaiye Rẹ ninu wa.

Awon aworan meji yi nse apejuwe orisi igbesiaiye meji:

IGBESIAIYE ENI TI NŞE AKOSO ARARE

Eni yi ndari aiye ara rẹ. Kristi (†) wa lode aiye yi. Awon àmì dudu yi, duro fun orisirisi ànìyàn igbesiaiye yi, gẹgẹbi, ẹşìn, owo, ìşẹ, ìsòro, ati bẹẹbẹẹ lọ ti ẹnì yi ndari. Şugbọn sibẹsibẹ ẹnì yi ko ni ifọkanbalẹ tó pè.

IGBESIAIYE TI KRISTI NŞE AKOSO RE

Nibi yi, Kristi (†) ti wọ inu igbesiaiye ẹnì yi lati dari rẹ. Ẹni yi jowọ anìyan aiye rẹ fun Kristi lati dari anìyan gẹgẹbi, Ẹşìn, owo, ìşẹ, ìsòro, ati bẹẹbẹẹ lọ. Eni yi ni ifọkanbalẹ pẹlu Ọlọrun.

YOU CAN RECEIVE CHRIST RIGHT NOW BY FAITH THROUGH PRAYER

God knows your heart and is not so concerned with your words as He is with the attitude of your heart. The following is a suggested prayer:

“Lord Jesus, I need You. Thank You for dying on the cross for my sins. I open the door of my life and receive You as my Savior and Lord. Thank You for forgiving my sins and giving me eternal life. Take control of the throne of my life. Make me the kind of person You want me to be. Amen.”

Does this prayer express the desire of your heart?

If it does, I invite you to pray this prayer right now, and Christ will come into your life, as He promised.

Did you receive Christ into your life? According to His promise in Revelation 3:20, where is Christ right now in relation to you? Christ said that He would come into your life. Would He mislead you? On what authority do you know that God has answered your prayer?

DON'T RELY ON FEELINGS

Thank God often that Christ is in your life and that He will never leave you (Hebrews 13:5). You can know on the basis of His promise that Christ lives in you and that you have eternal life from the very moment you invite Him in. He will not deceive you.

The moment that you received Christ by faith, as an act of the will, many things happened, including the following:

1. Christ came into your life (Revelation 3:20).
2. Your sins were forgiven (Colossians 1:14).
3. You became a child of God (John 1:12).
4. You received eternal life (John 5:11-13)
5. You began the great adventure for which God created you (John 10:10, 2 Corinthians 5:17).

Can you think of anything more wonderful that could happen to you than receiving Christ? Would you like to thank God in prayer right now for what He has done for you? By thanking God, you demonstrate your faith.

O LE GBA KKRISTI NISISIYI NIPA IGBAGBỌ

O le gba Kristi ni Olugbala ati Oluwa bi o ba gbadura pe ki Kristi wọ inu igbesiaiye rẹ wa. Ki o ni igbagbọ pe yio wa. Adura yi ni lati jẹ ọkantọkan. Ọlọrun mọ ọkan rẹ, o ko si leè tan A jẹ. Gba iru adura bayi:

"Jesu Oluwa, mo mọ wipe emi ni mo ti ndari aiye mi. Nitori eyi, mo ti dẹşẹ si Ọ. Jọwọ wa sinu aiye mi, wa dari ẹşẹ mi jì mi. Wa şe Alakoso igbesiaiye mi. Sọ mi di ẹni mimọ. Mo dupẹ pe, O ti gbọ adura mi. Amin."

Njẹ o fẹ lati gba adura yi?

Bi o ba fẹ bẹẹ, gba adura yi nisisiyi, Jesu yio si wa sinu igbesiaiye rẹ gẹgẹbi O ti şe ileri.

Njẹ o ti gba Kristi sinu aiye rẹ? Bawo ni o şe mọ? Boju wo ẹhin lati ri ileri Kristi ni Ifihan 3:20... A le mọ wipe Kristi wa ninu aiye wa nitoriwipe Kristi şe ileri lati wá. O kò tun ni lati pe Kristi wọle mọ.

MAŞE GBOJULE ERO ỌKAN RE

Inu rẹ le dun loni, Kristi yio si wa sinu igbesiaiye rẹ. Kristi wipe, "Emi ko jẹ fi ọ silẹ" (Heberu 13:5). Kọ lati máa gbẹkẹle awọn ileri Ọlọrun, ma gbẹkẹle ero ọkan rẹ.

Nigbati o gba kristi... ọpọlọpọ nkan ni o şeşẹ Diẹ ninu wọn niwọnyi:-

1. Kristi wa si inu igbesiaiye rẹ (Ifihan 3:20)
2. A dari ẹşẹ rẹ ji ọ (Kolose 1:14).
3. O di ọmọ Ọlọrun(Johannu 1:12).
4. O ni iyè ainipẹkun (1Johannu 5:11-1 3).
5. O bẹrẹ si ni iriri igbesiaiye titun ti o ni itẹlọrun bi kKristi ti ngbe igbesiaiye Rẹ ninu rẹ (Johannu 10:10; 2 Korinti 5:17).

Òpò Ìlérí bayi ati ju bée lọ lati inu ọrọ Ọlọrun ni nwọn je tire. Yẹ nwọn wo ninu Bibeli. Ni Ise-Awọn-Apósteli 17:11 nwọn nyẹ Iwe Mimọ wò lojojumọ "bi nkan wọnyi ri bée".

SUGGESTIONS FOR CHRISTIAN GROWTH

Go to God in prayer daily (Luke 18:1).

Read God's Word daily (Ps 119:11); begin with the Gospel of John.

Obey God moment by moment (John 14:21).

Witness for Christ by your life and words (Luke 18:39).

Trust God for every detail of your life (1 Peter 5:7).

Holy Spirit - allow Him to control and empower your daily life and witness (Galatians 5:16,17; Acts 1:8).

God's Word instructs us not to forsake *"the assembling of ourselves together"* (Hebrews 10:25). Start going to church where Christ is honoured and His Word is preached. Start this week, and make plans to attend regularly.
